---

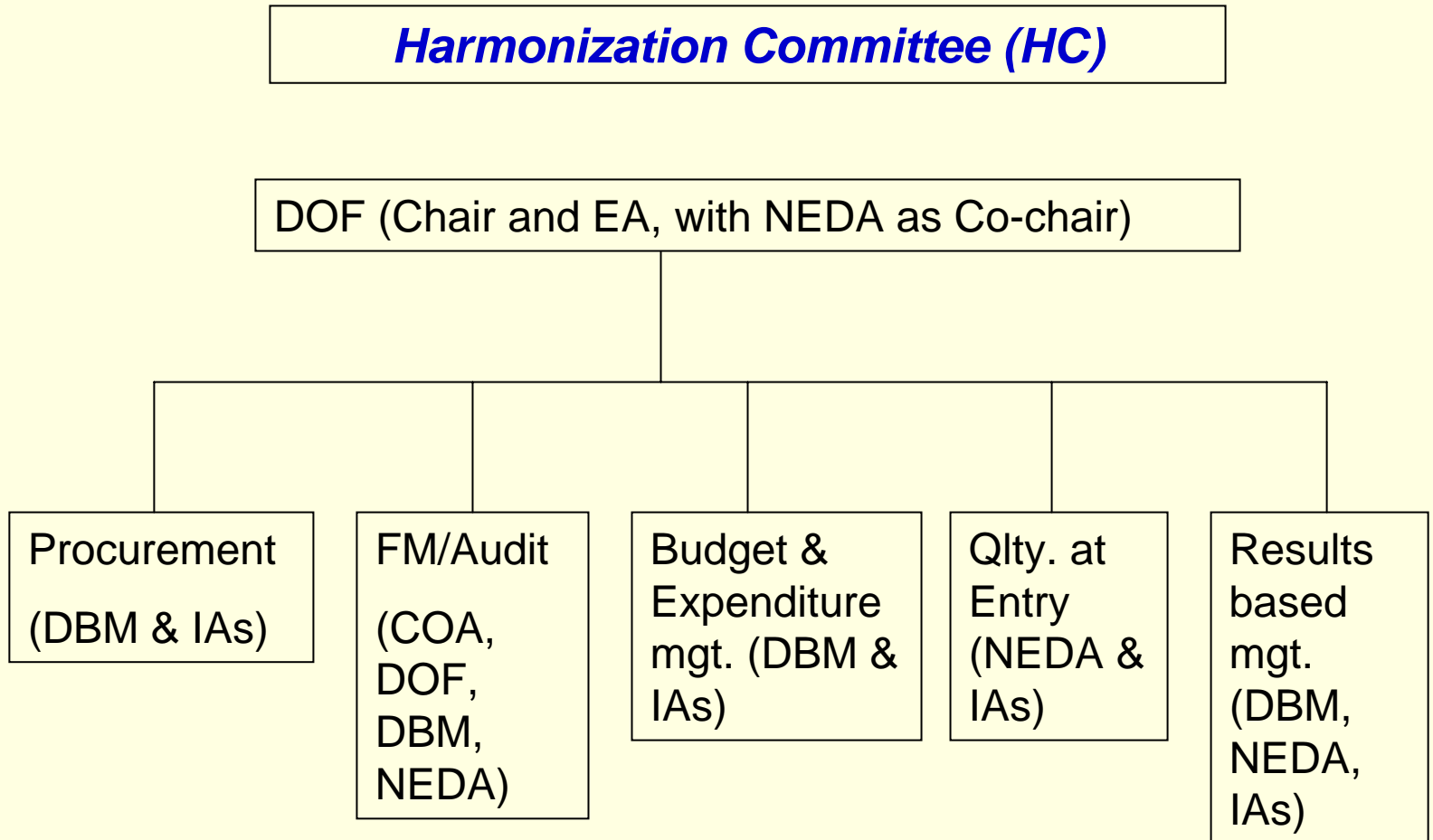
- The TA supports the country's response to the global call for ownership, harmonization, alignment, results and mutual accountability under the Paris Declaration of March 2005.
  
- The **Primary Objective** of the TA is to enhance effectiveness and efficiency of development by:
  1. Encouraging rationalized and simplified procedures for better implementation of development projects.
  2. Aligning development partner activities with the Government's planning cycle and development agenda.
  3. Harmonizing the dev. Partners' policies and procedures among themselves and with those of the Gov's to minimize costs and delays

# TA will focus on achieving results on:

---

- Developing a **tracking mechanism to monitor the country's progress** toward meeting the identified country-level indicators.
- Further raising the level of harmonization in **standard bidding procedures and bidding documents for local competitive** bidding for goods, works and consulting services.
- Enhancing the Gov's capacity for **financial management and audit**, and developing technical readiness to create a more effective and efficient financial management and monitoring system for public resource utilization and management.
- Identifying a results framework for performance budgeting, including strengthening the **GOP's effectiveness and efficiency reviews (EERs) and the organizational performance indicator framework (OPIF)**.
- Improving the effectiveness of ODA by ensuring quality at entry of projects through alignment of the Gov's practices with dev. Partners' **safeguard policies in the areas of gender, resettlement, and environment**.
